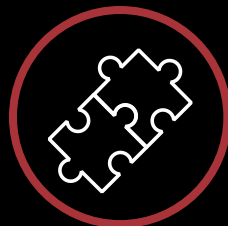

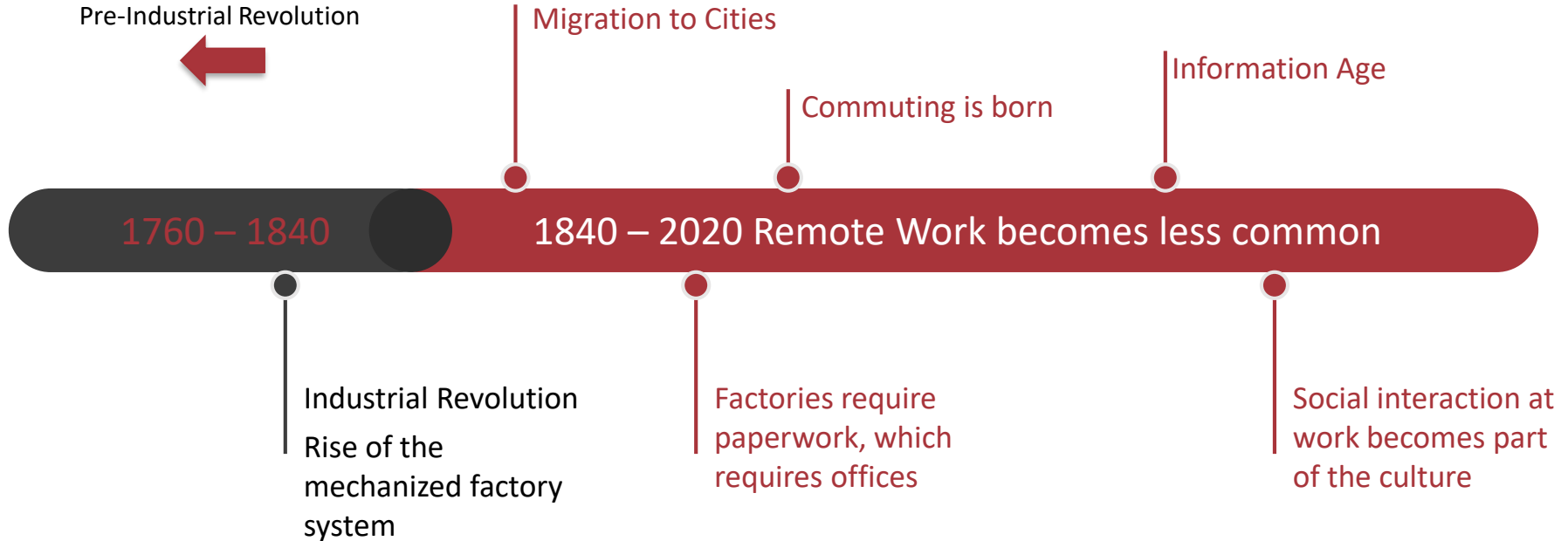

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE



INSIGHTS

- Processing paper has become processing data
- Work has evolved from “somewhere you go” to “something you do”
- Remote work emphasized outcomes over activities
- Without conscious effort, culture is LOST



INSIGHTS

BUSINESS INSIGHTS

- Remote work that is happening now is the most efficient structure – no commute means more working hours, and higher productivity
