Members & Meetings



The Forum has CIO, Vendor, and SNG (Security Networking Group) Memberships

- **All memberships must be approved by the Board.**
- **CIO and Vendor Members participate in nine (9) Forums and two (2) Social events.**
- **SNG Members participate in two (2) Cybersecurity Forums and two (2) SNG Meetings. They may attend two (2) Social events for an additional fee.**
- **Membership fees are due in the First Quarter of the Forum year (July – September).**

Meetings Are Held from September to May

- **They are typically held on the Towson University campus.**
- **Selected meetings are held at Member and other special locations as approved by the Board.**
- **Meetings are by invitations only. Registration is Required.**
- **Vendor Members are to restrict marketing and stay focused to CIO issues.**
- **Open conversations and networking are encouraged at all meetings and events.**



How We Operate



- **The Mid-Atlantic CIO Forum is a nonprofit supported by membership fees.**
- **Directed by a Board of Directors elected annually from our CIO Members and with a Towson University Representative and an SNG appointed member.**
- **Administered by the Forum President reporting to the Board.**
- **An Annual Program of meetings and events is developed and published before the next Forum Year starting in July.**
- **Speakers are from our membership and selected based on their level of expertise. Gartner and nationally prominent speakers are invited as needed.**
- **Networking is promoted at meetings, events, through the website, and by other means of collaboration.**
