Fee Schedule Addendum

Effective Date: July 1, 2026

Applies To: Membership Year July 1 – June 30

Approved By: Board of Directors, Mid-Atlantic CIO Forum

1. Purpose

This Fee Schedule Addendum defines all membership fees, special fees, and proration rules applicable to the Mid-Atlantic CIO Forum. This Addendum is maintained separately from the Membership Policy and may be updated by approval of the Board of Directors without requiring modification of the Membership Policy.

2. CIO Membership Fees

2.1 Standard CIO Membership Fees

The annual CIO membership fees are as follows:

Organization Type	Annual Fee
For-Profit Organization	\$5,250
Non-Profit Organization	\$3,675
Government Organization	\$3,675

No exceptions to these fees are permitted unless explicitly approved by the Board in accordance with the Membership Policy.

2.2 Multiple CIOs from the Same Organization

With Board approval, an organization may have more than one CIO participate as a member.

- The first CIO from an organization pays the full applicable CIO membership fee.
- Each additional CIO from the same organization pays an annual fee of **\$2,000**.

Each CIO must independently meet CIO membership criteria or receive a Board-approved exception.

3. Vendor Membership Fees

3.1 Full Vendor Membership

- **Annual Fee:** \$7,875
- Full Vendor members may participate in all Forum meetings and events.

3.2 SNG Vendor Membership

- **Annual Fee:** \$2,625
- SNG Vendor members may participate only in the March and November Forums and the social events planned each year.

No exceptions to vendor membership fees are permitted.

4. CIO Member-In-Kind Fees

- **Annual Fee:** \$500

The Board may waive this fee at its discretion.

5. CIO Emeritus Membership Fees

- **Fee:** \$0 (No charge)

Emeritus membership is a lifetime designation and is not subject to annual fees.

6. Guest and Unemployed CIO Participation Fees

- Guest CIOs may participate in up to two approved meetings at no cost.
- Unemployed CIOs may participate in up to two approved meetings at no cost.

Any transition to full membership is subject to proration as defined in this Addendum.

7. Proration Rules

- Members or vendors joining after the start of the membership year will have fees prorated based on the remaining portion of the membership year.
- If the Board requests a member or vendor to discontinue membership, fees will be refunded on a prorated basis for the remainder of the membership year.
- If a member or vendor voluntarily terminates membership, a prorated rebate may be issued in accordance with the Membership Policy.
- Guest CIOs who become members will have membership fees prorated back to the first meeting attended.

All proration calculations are based on the membership year running from July 1 through June 30.

8. Governance and Revisions

- This Fee Schedule Addendum may be amended at any time by approval of the Board of Directors.
- Changes to this Addendum do not require revision or reapproval of the Membership Policy.
- The most current Board-approved version of this Addendum governs all membership fees.
